STEP ONE

STEP TWO

Candidate Receives Score Report

A score of **23 and above** indicates a readiness to test. However, further review and preparation in all domain areas that show weakness are encouraged.

STEP THREE

Submit Application to NSCA.

STEP FOUR

Register

- A.** Candidates may take the exam at an authorized testing center in the U.S. in a computer based environment. Upon approval of the application, an email is sent to the candidate from NSCA with a username and password to access the registration site and pay for the exam. Exam cost: \$249.00.
- B.** Candidates, who plan to take the exam at an NSCA University event, will receive confirmation information from NSCA and be charged upon approval of the application. Exam cost: \$249.00.

STEP FIVE

Test Time

- A.** Candidates who take the exam at an authorized testing center will receive an admission letter (email) and passcode upon completion of the registration. The candidate must bring the admission letter to the testing center with a valid photo ID.
- B.** Candidates who take the exam at NSCA University event will receive confirmation email from a NSCA University Associate.

STEP SIX

Test Results

- A.** If taking the exam at an authorized testing center, candidates receive preliminary pass or fail notification immediately following completion of the exam. Approximately 30 days after taking the test, a formal results explanation will be mailed.
- B.** If taking the exam at NSCA University event, the candidate will receive a formal results explanation approximately 30 days after taking the test.
