NSCA Education Foundation Scholarship

The NSCA Education Foundation is a charitable organization that supports educational initiatives which make the current and incoming workforce more efficient, reduce costs of doing business, promote a standard level of technical knowledge and bring trained professionals into the workforce.

Student Requirements

- High school senior or college undergraduate student.
- Minimum 2.0 grade point average.
- Must be pursuing studies leading to a career in the electronic systems industry or related field.
- *Current high school seniors* should provide a letter of acceptance indicating that you have enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution.

Application Procedures

- The application must be filled out completely to be considered for a scholarship.
- Send official sealed transcripts, which should include the first semester/quarter of the current academic year for students who are currently enrolled in high school or college.
- Include two letters of recommendation from (a non-family member) employer, career counselor or professional on company letterhead.
- All incomplete applications will be returned unprocessed, there are no exceptions for late or incomplete applications.
- Applications must be received by **April 18, 2008**.

Selection Process

Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis to qualified graduating high school seniors and to qualified undergraduate students. A scholarship judging panel composed of industry leaders will select award recipients based upon the following: presentation of application (spelling, punctuation, etc), grade point average, work experience, and strength of letters of recommendation. Scholarship applications and supporting documentation become property of NSCA Education Foundation and will not be returned to the applicant.

Award Procedures

- Applicants will be notified of their award status via US Mail. Announcements are expected to be mailed to all recipients by **July 3, 2008** and the winners will be posted on the NSCA Education Foundation website (www.nscfoundation.org). We encourage you to check the website for updates on the schedule of awards.
- Scholarship awards are distributed once an acknowledgment or thank-you letter has been received from the recipient.
- Award Amount: \$1000 (applicable for payment of tuition only)
- Awards will be sent to the school (not to students) and administered by NSCA Education Foundation and your college/university so that your tuition is prepaid by NSCA Education Foundation.
- Winning students will also be awarded a complimentary NSCA student membership for one school year.
