Rankings were composite scores calculated purely on the basis of employee responses. The rankings in the Star Tribune Top 150 Workplaces are based on survey information collected by Energage, formerly WorkplaceDynamics, an independent company specializing in employee engagement and retention.

IdentiSys was ranked #24 out of 70 companies on the small company list.
